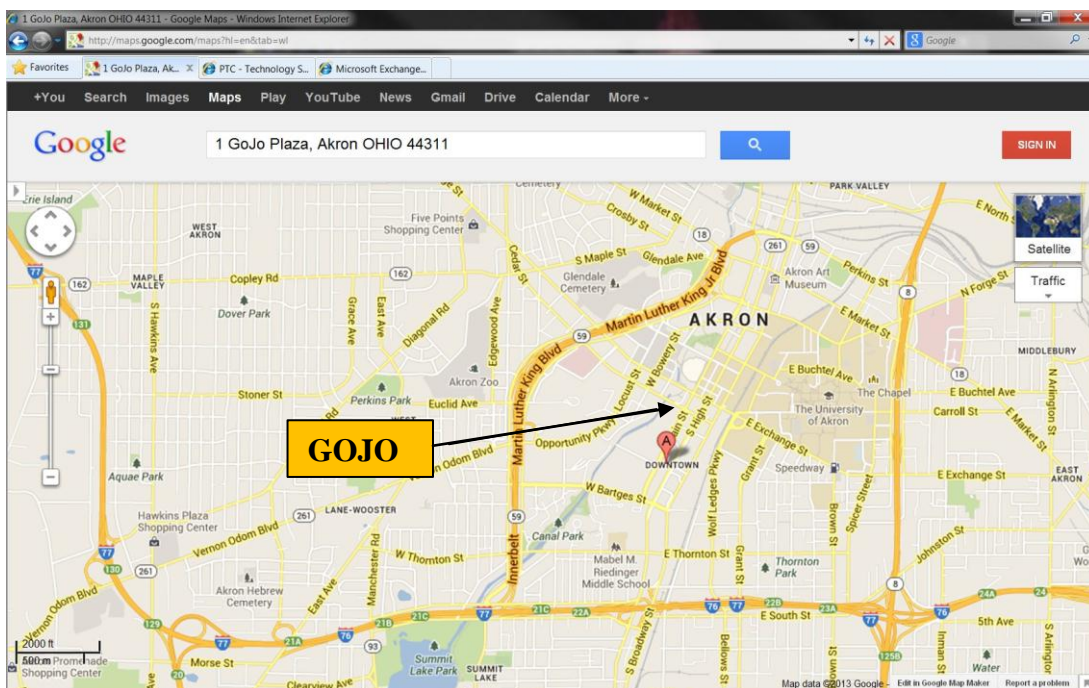
Traveling from I-77 south bound:
