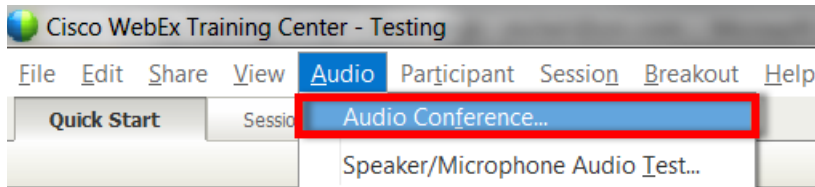

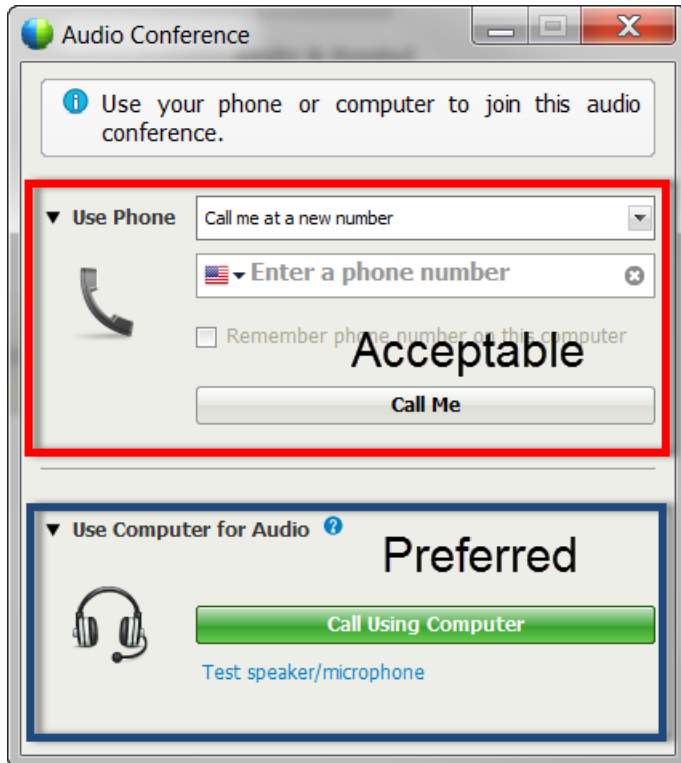

- For our purposes, we will be using predominantly the Chat pane

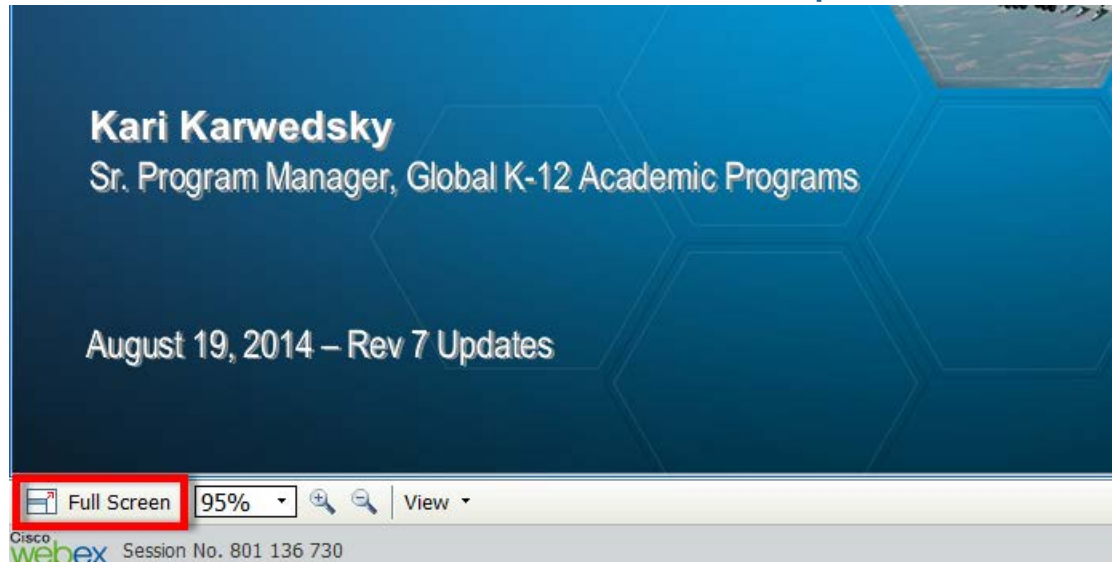


- In the Chat pane you can select who your message goes to
