(Don't you want your team to be focused?)



Why Make A Business Plan?


- It'l let you set specific goals for your team.
- It'll help you share your strategies with other teams.
- It'll help you decide what roles you need to have filled on the team.
- It'll help you decide what assets you need for your team and robot.
- It'll help draw in sponsors.
- It'll help you more seamlessly bring in more volunteers.



- Executive Summary
 - Briefly describe: Who you are, what you do, how you do it, as well as your goals.
 - Mission Statement
 - Purpose of this plan
 - Sponsors?
 - More Members?
 - Fun?



- Team's Description
 - A history of the team that includes awards, and a list of the events attended in the past.
 - A summary of the team's growth.
 - A summary of the team's finances and assets.
 - Clearly state the teams short-term, and long-term goals.




- Your Product and Your Service
 - A Robot
 - Improving the Future of Humankind!



- Market Analysis, Strategy, and Implementation
 - Sketch the desired size of you team and how many people will serve in each area.
 - Include an outlook of your local economy here to demonstrate how your team serves a need.
 - Address how you will reach your target audience (Students, Parents, Volunteers)
 - Write a simple timeline to show how the teams functions through out the year.





- Organization of Management Team
 - Organization Chart is always valuable
 - Information on Key Sponsors
 - Profile of Management Team
 - List of any Advisors




Financial Plan and Projections

This helps students see where the money goes, and how much needs to be raised.




