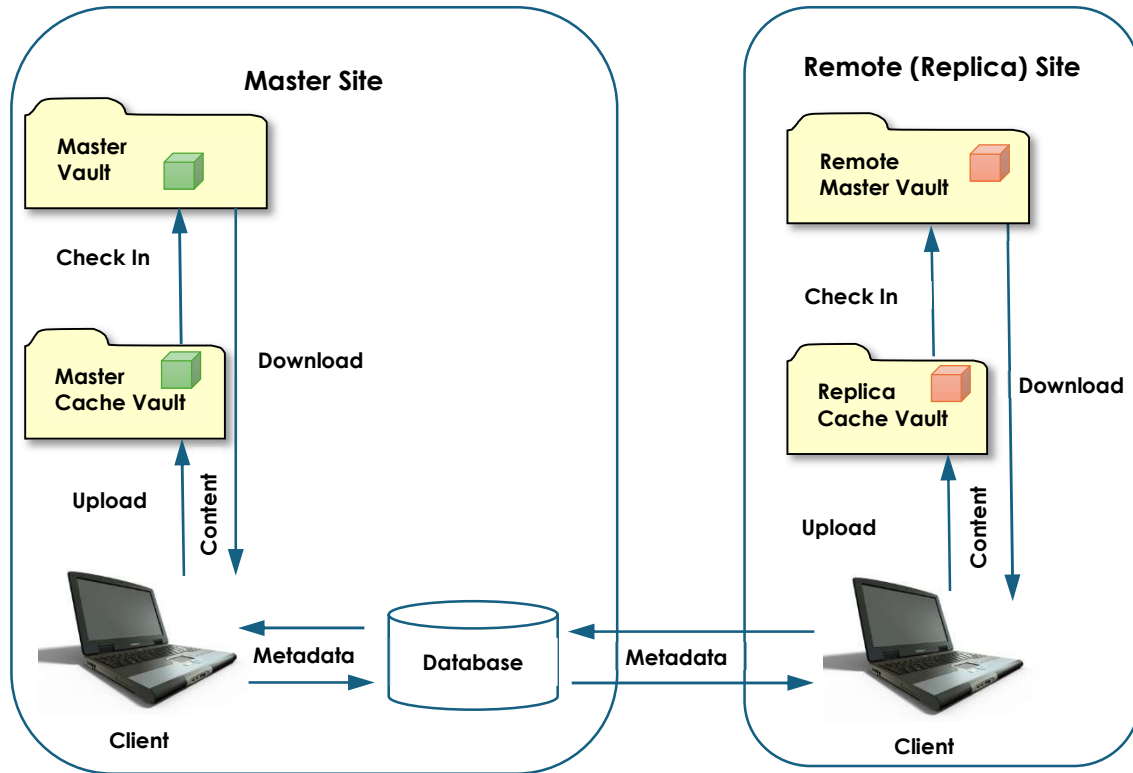


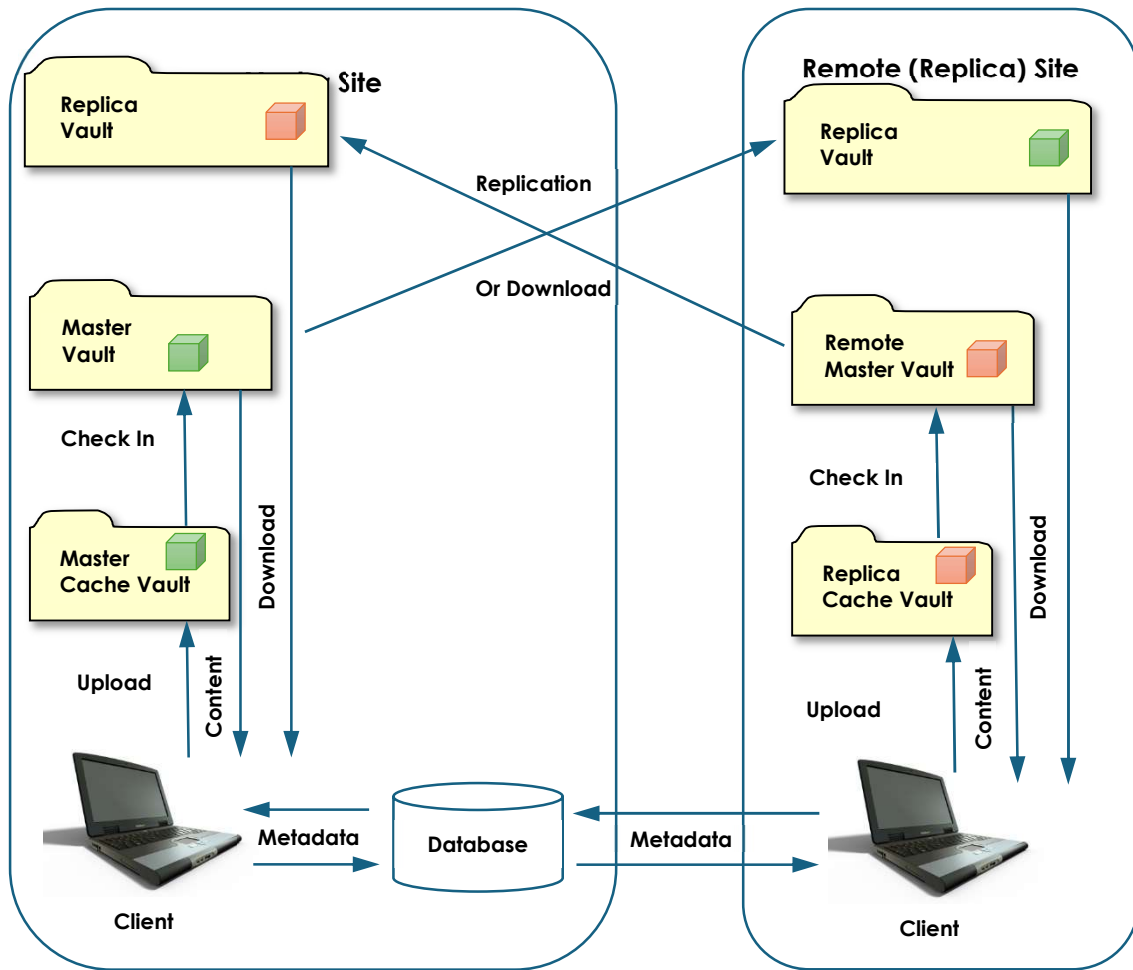
Remote Masters

Some companies design completely different products at different sites. Under these conditions, there is no data sharing between sites and no reason to replicate. Each site has master vaults for its location and the only sharing between sites is the metadata transfer.



Remote Masters

In this example no data is shared between the sites. It is also possible for a company to use remote masters and still share data via replication. This approach works well when a subset of content (e.g. library data or product component) is mastered and maintained at only one location but referenced at another location.



Remote Masters with Replication

Notice in this diagram the replicated content is not modifiable by that site. This is not always the case and it is possible to configure remote masters with replication so all data can be modified at all locations. However, this is a rare case.
