Try

Step 1) Retrieve the family table instance.

Step 2) Create a surface copy of the entire model by changing the selection preferences to smart or geometry, query select a segment of the model, right click, choose solid surfaces, then in the toolbar pick the copy icon, next pick the paste icon and pick on the check mark icon.
(this will create a surface copy entire model, this technique has been around since the introduction of Wildfire)

Step 3) Select #View, #ModelSetup, #ColorAppearances.

Step 4) From the dialog box select the color to apply, select #Quilts and select the surface that was just created. Select #Done Sel.

Step 5) Accept the default arrow direction. Select #Set from the dialog box and the color will be applied to the surface.

Step 6) Shade the model to see the color displayed.
