Select Word file > Open > OK • Workaround 2: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Open bitmap file in Paint 2. Select All > Copy 3. In Pro/ENGINEER, Insert > Object > Create New > Paintbrush Picture/Bitmap File 4. Paste image into new window. 5. Save and Close Paint
